

# Demystifying the SAT & ACT at Bartow High School

This course has been offered in Central Florida since 1997. Former students have been admitted to top-tier universities across the United States (e.g., the Ivy League, MIT, Hopkins, and Stanford) as well as throughout Florida and received millions of dollars in scholarships.
